## A Note from the Pastor:

"Listen to the Word that God has spoken; listen to the One who is close at hand. Listen to the voice who began creation; listen even when you don't understand." These are the lyrics to a sung prayer from an Inuit Christian community in northern Canada. I first heard them during a conference where John Bell was talking about scriptures that we wrestle with. Focused on several Old Testament passages especially from the book of Judges, "listen even when you don't understand" became something of a refrain as we wondered aloud together what 'good news' some of these difficult passages had for the modern believer.

We all have (or *should* have) stories in the Book that We Love that we struggle with. Taking the Bible seriously means grappling with the implications of the narrative. From parables that make us uncomfortable to prophets that give us pause, wrestling with God's Word is a practice as old as the word itself (just read Genesis 32). The rabbis tell us that continuing to turn a passage over, to ask questions of it, to converse with friends and fellow believers about it—through that process God is showing you a path to wisdom, because the Word is always a gift of life. May we be so blessed in all our wrestling! As we listen carefully, I pray we hear the voice of God close at hand in the coming days.


