Our newly elected Elders were invited to this meeting to “get their feet wet” and to allow them to be familiar with some of the items that are currently being addressed for our church. Training for the new Elders is in the works and we hope to have them installed for active service soon!

Becky Allen is preparing the Session book for the annual review by Presbytery which will be happening in August and September.

The food service permit from the Mercer County Health Department has been renewed so we may be allowed to have dinner in the fellowship hall when the need arises.

Permission to use the church for a memorial service for Donnie and Eleanor Kensinger was obtained along with approval for WD Hasty to come and perform that service on August 4th at 2:00pm.

The date was set for a patriotic concert to be held in the church sanctuary on September 11th. Harold Brown will be choosing music and inviting special guests, both singers and instrumentalists, to join our choir in presenting selections to celebrate all that is wonderful about America!

Renovations to the third floor are not quite completed but the contractor is looking for someone to do the tile work for the shower. Our third floor has already been utilized by a visiting mission group in June and the improvements to date helped make their stay more convenient. Fred Dodson reported that the repair work to the outside of the church building is nearly done and that the contractors doing the painting and tuck pointing are going above and beyond what was expected of them to maintain the safety and beauty of our church!
