SESSION STREAM

Session met on December 20th, 2022. Kristi Moore moderated the meeting via ZOOM.

Clerk Report: Melinda and Greg had attended the Presbytery meeting in November at Davis-Elkins and gave a brief report from the meeting where many resolutions had been voted on by those in attendance. Becky advised the group that year end reports for presbytery will be due in January and February and she will be working on those along with Stephanie to get them completed and submitted. Each year a financial review is required by presbytery (this is NOT an official audit) and must be done by 2 people from the church, neither of whom may be the treasurer or related to the treasurer. This will need to be done before the Session book is submitted for review in the Spring. Also, our current insurance carrier has sent a letter that they will no longer be insuring churches in WV so we are looking for a new insurance provider for the church. We are working on creating a system to make sure cleaning supplies and toiletries get ordered in a timely manner.

The Stewardship /Finance committee has completed the 2023 budge and it will be submitted for approval at the January meeting after Session has had time to review it.

The Congregational Care committee made up and distributed 15 gift bags to shut-ins for Christmas.

The Missions Committee Blessing Box cold weather project has been very successful.

Worship Committee Chair Daveen has pulpit supply for January covered and Lay Leaders scheduled for January and February.

The PNC met just prior to Session meeting and made revisions to the Ministry form for submission to Ed Thompson from presbytery.

John Feuchtenberger has contacted the radio station about the inadequacies in the radio broadcast and Eric is going to go speak with them in person to see what can be done to improve this service.

A new nominating committee will be addressed in February so if you have any wish to serve on this committee please let the church office or John Eckman know.

An update was received from Presbytery about incorporation. If any church had already completed their incorporation paperwork the incorporation will be honored by the State. Those who have not completed it should simply hold off until further notice. (Continued on page after calendar.)
