We received a letter from Presbytery about paying \$75.00 to pastors who moderate meetings for us and are setting that up with Ann to automatically pay when that occurs.

**Property/Personnel (Fred):** Third floor dorm area just needs some decorative items and touch up painting taken care of and it will be complete. The Recovery area is nearly completed. They are buying new tables for their meeting area and an open house is planned for a date when both areas are completed. We had another water leak in the parking lot area which has been repaired. The courtyard floor needs repair work and we have enough funds left over from other projects in that area to hopefully complete that. The Recovery group wishes to contribute financially and to help with the actual work as well since they use that area when the weather is nice.
