A Moment for Reflection

Greetings Church Family and Friends,

February has been designated as the month of love. One of my favorite verses in the Bible, and one I feel sure is a favorite of others, speaks of love. It is 1 Corinthians 13:13. I like it so much that I placed the King James Version of it elsewhere in this newsletter. Here is the New Revised Standard Version of it that we have available here in our church pews: "And now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; and the greatest of these is love."

I know everyone reads and interprets words in their own way. And we pray that God will have us understand His words in the way He intended. When I read the entire chapter 13 of 1 Corinthians, it says to me that we all have different gifts which we are to use to serve God. But if there is not love behind them, these gifts and the things we do for others, mean nothing.
